3. I will not try to hide damage to the instrument or case.
4. I will tell Mr. Kools as soon as possible if the instrument or case does break.
5. I will take care in putting away and taking out the instrument from it's case.
6. I will practice my instrument.
7. I will sign out my instrument so Mr. Kools knows where it is.
8. I will bring the instrument back to school on the next school day (in case of illness call the school and leave Mr. Kools a message)
